Dear parent,

If you live close to the River Pinn and/or Cannon Brook, Hillingdon Council and the Environment Agency are inviting you to an informal public drop-in about our flood reduction proposals. The event is open to everyone, so if you know someone that is interested, whether they live near to the proposals or not, please feel free to invite them.

Hillingdon and Harrow Councils, and the Environment Agency have organised these joint sessions as an opportunity for you to find out more about the ideas we are looking at to reduce flooding in the River Pinn and Cannon Brook area. We would also like to record everyone's experience of flooding and welcome comments on the proposals. If you have been affected by flooding in the past you may benefit if these proposals eventually lead to a scheme.

It is intended to run three drop-ins, covering different sections of the River Pinn proposals. Two of those are within Hillingdon Borough and the third within Harrow, but we will have information for the whole Pinn at all of these events. You are of course welcome to join any of these sessions.

Drop-in 2 Pinner & Hatch End. 4 – 8pm on 19 March 2018

Pinner Cricket Club, Montsole Court, Pinner. HA5 3SA

Drop-in 3 Ickenham, Uxbridge & Yiewsley. 4 – 8pm on 21 March 2018

Hillingdon Civic Centre, 225-226 High Street, Uxbridge. UB8 1UW

There will also be an opportunity to discuss flood warnings and river maintenance with council and Environment Agency staff at all three events. Thames Water will be attending the drop-in at the Kings Café.
